



## Internship Programme

Valley Equine Hospital offers two, 13 month internship positions at the only hospital in the Valley of the Racehorse. The internship is a very hands on, intense and rewarding programme, that will be tailored to your future career plans.

The mentorship of our interns is led by our in house surgeon, accompanied by our ambulatory team, and other boarded specialists in surgery, medicine, diagnostic imaging and anaesthesia, from the wider CVS hospital network.

We take great pride in the professional development of our interns, and ensure that by the time they graduate our internship they are confident, technically proficient and independent thinkers with a wealth of experience.

### Internship Structure:

Our two interns alternate between anaesthesia/surgical cases, and inpatient care/outpatient workups. The on call responsibility is split based on a 1 in 2 rota, with 28 days holiday and generous CPD opportunities.

The surgeon implements a structure in which the interns are involved closely in all hospital cases, ensuring interns have primary case responsibility, and case continuity from admission to discharge.



Our case load at Valley Equine Hospital is predominantly a mix of Thoroughbred race horses in training and performance sports horses, with a smaller population of pleasure horses and donkeys.

Our internship programme is part of the BEVA recognised internship programme, which ensures our interns start their careers in a well structured, professional environment. Additionally our interns are members of the CVS New Graduate Programme which provides extensive CPD opportunities, BEVA membership and provides them with a New Graduate mentor within the practice.
